EAST YORKS: Dentist who travelled to Morocco treated 50 children 'Trip was so rewarding'

AN EAST Riding dentist who helped to treat 50 children in Morocco has told how it was one of the most rewarding experiences of his life.

Chris Branfield, 40, of Beverley, is owner and principal dentist at Castle Park Dental Care in Cottingham and was one of four dentists who travelled to the country to treat youngsters from the Berber tribe in El Jebha, a small port town in the Rif Mountains.

Chris is one of the founding trustees of a new charity that aims

to increase the role dentists can play in charity work in remote parts of the world.

They had initially planned to treat people whose problem is gingivitis – inflammation of the gums surrounding the teeth.

However, they teamed up with an existing charity in the country and helped to treat 50 children with dental problems, including decay.

Chris, a father-of-two who has been a dentist for almost 18 years, said the team also raised awareness of the importance of dental hygiene.

"It was fantastic and emotional," he said. "I was overwhelmed by it. I went out there expecting just gum problems, but there was a massive dental decay problem and we saw lots of kids with stumps left for teeth and abscesses.

"It's one of the most rewarding experiences of my life."

Chris said he hoped to return to the country next year to carry out more work with a larger team.

"We want to go back next year and make it bigger and better."

Rare ivory monkey's head on sale

HAWLEYS Auctioneers will hold its annual autumn catalogue sale of quality antiques and collectibles this weekend. Taking place at Beverley Racecourse from 11am on Sunday, one of the highlights will be a large collection of Holderness Hunt mem-

orabilia, including scrapbooks containing press cuttings relating to the hunt from the 1920s and 1930s.

One cutting refers to a Hunt Ball taking place in 1928 at Tranby Croft, now Hull Collegiate School.

There is also a valuable collection of copper and silver hunting horns, hunt jackets and boots.

One of the other star lots is an unusual ivory monkey's head, which forms the handle of a

19th century parasol. Featured in a recent broadcast of the Antiques Roadshow, when it was filmed at Beverley Minster, this cheeky monkey sticks out his tongue at the press of a button and has an estimate of £1,000 to £1,500.

There is also an oil on panel seascape by acclaimed local artist Henry Redmore, estimated to sell for

£1,500 to £2,500. There is an interesting ceramics section too, which includes a Chinese bottle vase, Royal Dux, Royal Crown Derby and Royal Doulton.

For those wishing to buy early for Christmas, there is a large quantity of quality silver and jewellery to suit all tastes and budgets.

The full collection can be viewed at the racecourse in advance, on Saturday from 10am to 8pm.
